
SOMETHING NEW AT FRIENDSHIP

Table Shoot



At the spring national shoot. June 13th through the 20th

Located between, the Youth line and Chunk gun line, west end of the rifle Range.

Simple & fun for all shooters: young, old, female and male, beginner, veteran or physically challenged. Come find out what it's about.

The shooter and the fun are back in the game.

Shooters will use a common table and seat provided by the range. The muzzle will be supported by a pyramid of 2X4s provided by range. The rest may be covered with no more than 2 layers of cloth or leather to protect finish of rifle. No double rest will be allowed, the rear portion of the rifle must be supported by the shooter

Open class: The rifle may be either flint or percussion ignition, of either the traditional hunting or traditional target type, with no limit as to caliber. The rifle may not weigh than more than 13 pounds unloaded, including all apparatuses which will be on the rifle at the time of firing. The rifle may not be equipped with a false muzzle or rubber recoil pad. 1 Shot on each of 3 targets shortest string measure wins. Shooter furnishes own sighter.

Hunter class: No in-line action, sealed ignition or under hammer. (Tradional side hammers only) No false muzzles, rubber recoil pads or Teflon patching are allowed. Weight: 10 pounds or less unloaded including all apparatuses which will be on the rifle at the time of firing. Rifle As per Rule 5630 (The ramrod need not be installed at the time of firing) Caliber: 50 or under. Sights: per rule 5010 and 5020. Set triggers and Shaders are allowed. 3 shots, 1 Shot on each of 3 targets shortest string measure wins. Shooter furnishes own sighter.
